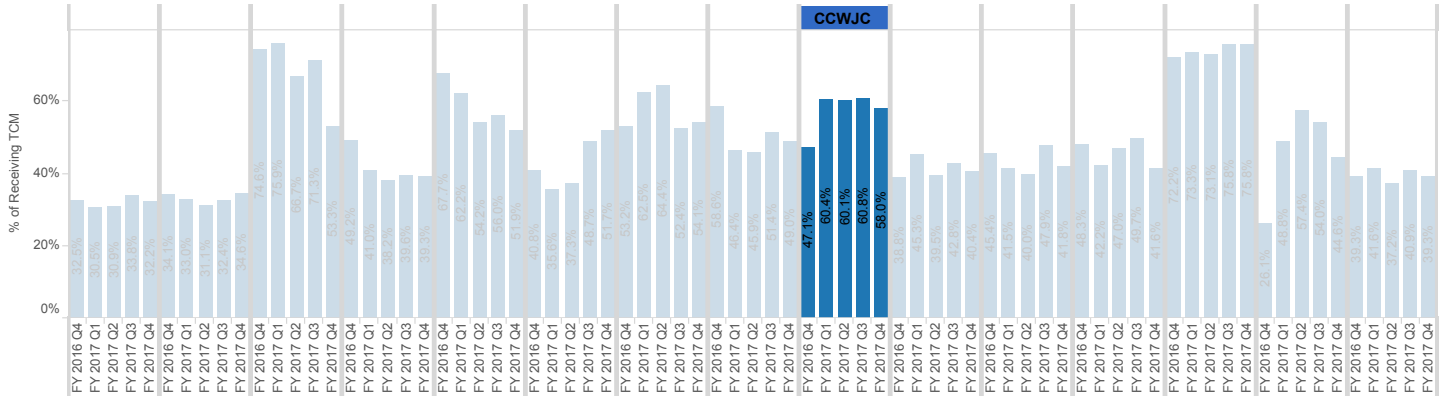

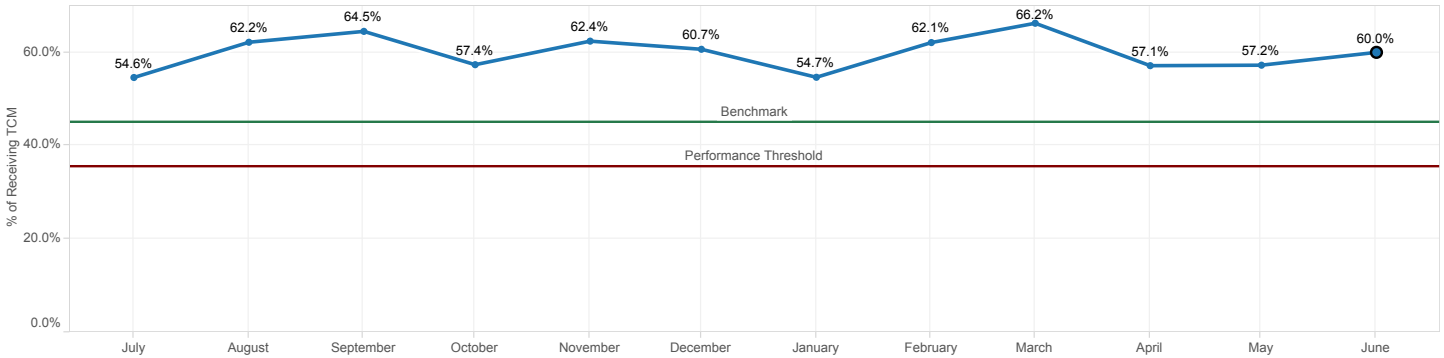


**Current Statewide Benchmark**

**Measure Definition**

**Percent of Priority N3CN Enrollees Receiving Transitional Care (Care Management after Hospital Discharge)**

**Denominator:**

Non-dual N3CN enrollees (including Health Choice) identified as priority for Transitional Care during the month who were discharged to home from an acute inpatient hospitalization during the month. Enrollees are considered Transitional Care Priority if their TC Impactability Score is 200 or greater. TC Impactability scores range from 0 – 1,000 and the score represents the incremental dollar savings PMPM in the follow-up period when the patient receives transitional care intervention.

**Numerator:**

Patients who received Transitional Care Management with a case status of Heavy or Medium within 30 days of hospital discharge to home. This is evidenced by documentation of tasks, interventions, and goals with patients/caregivers in CMIS according to CCNC documentation guidelines.

**Benchmark:** 98% of the mean of SFY 2016 performance
